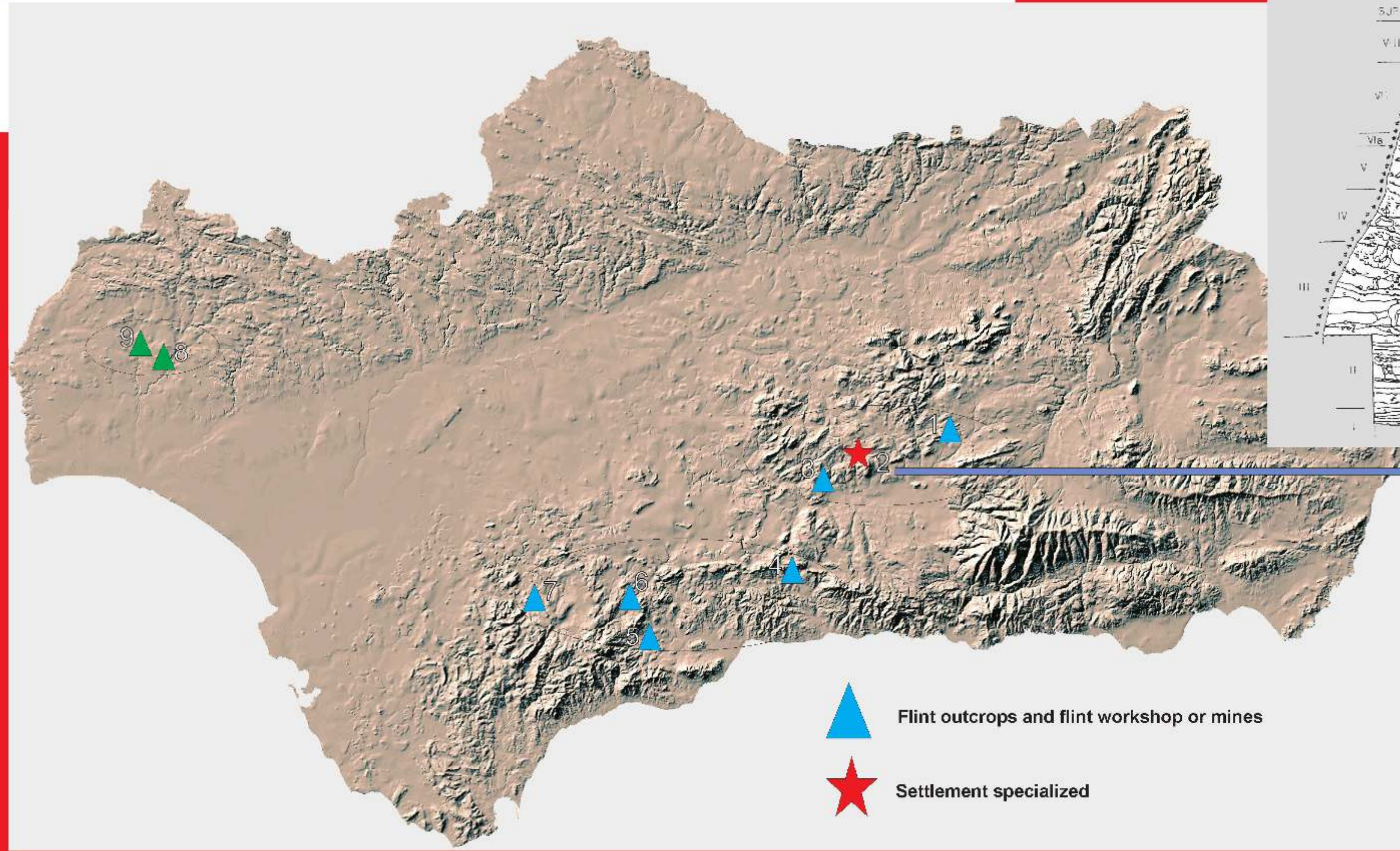

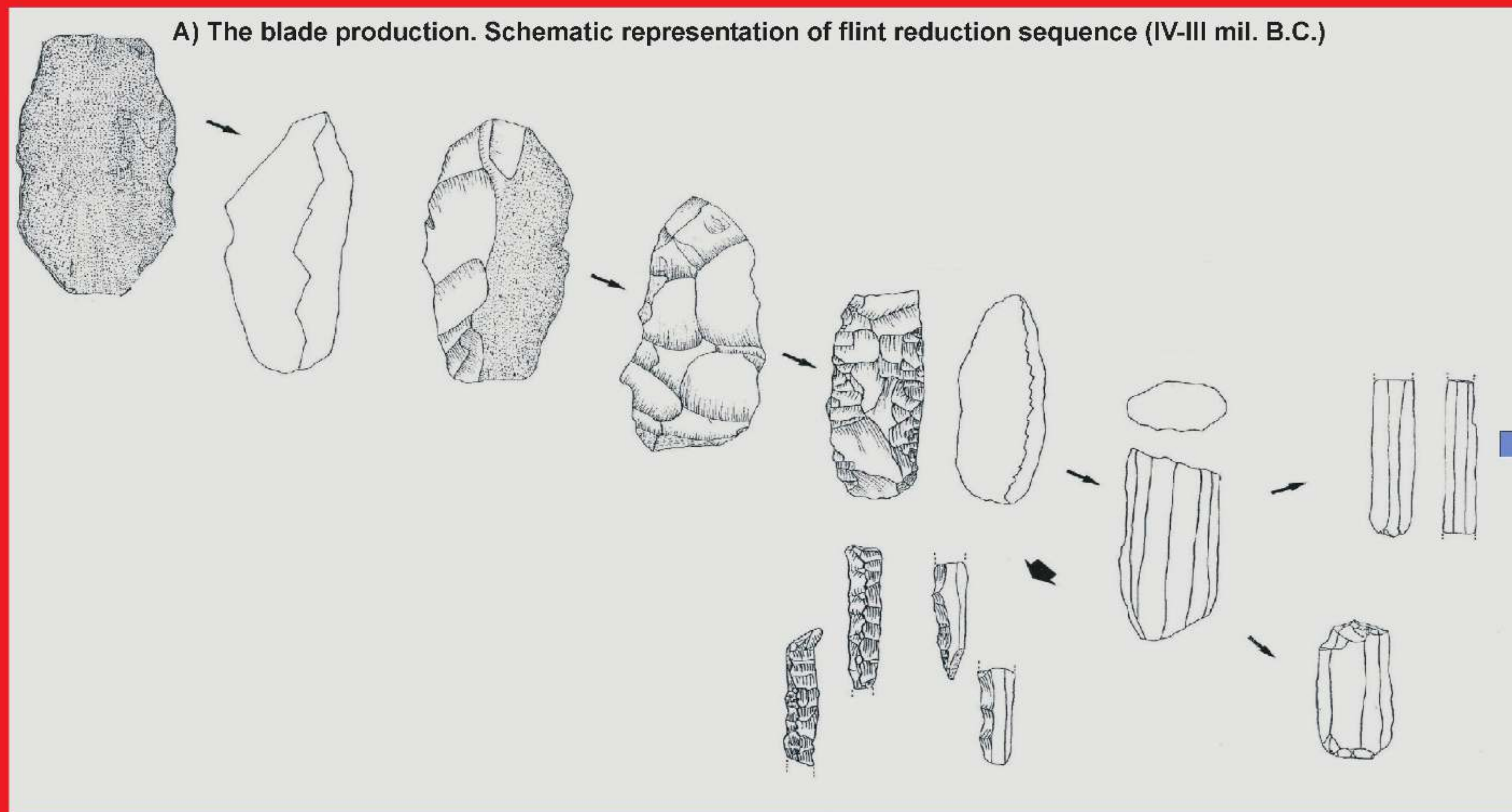

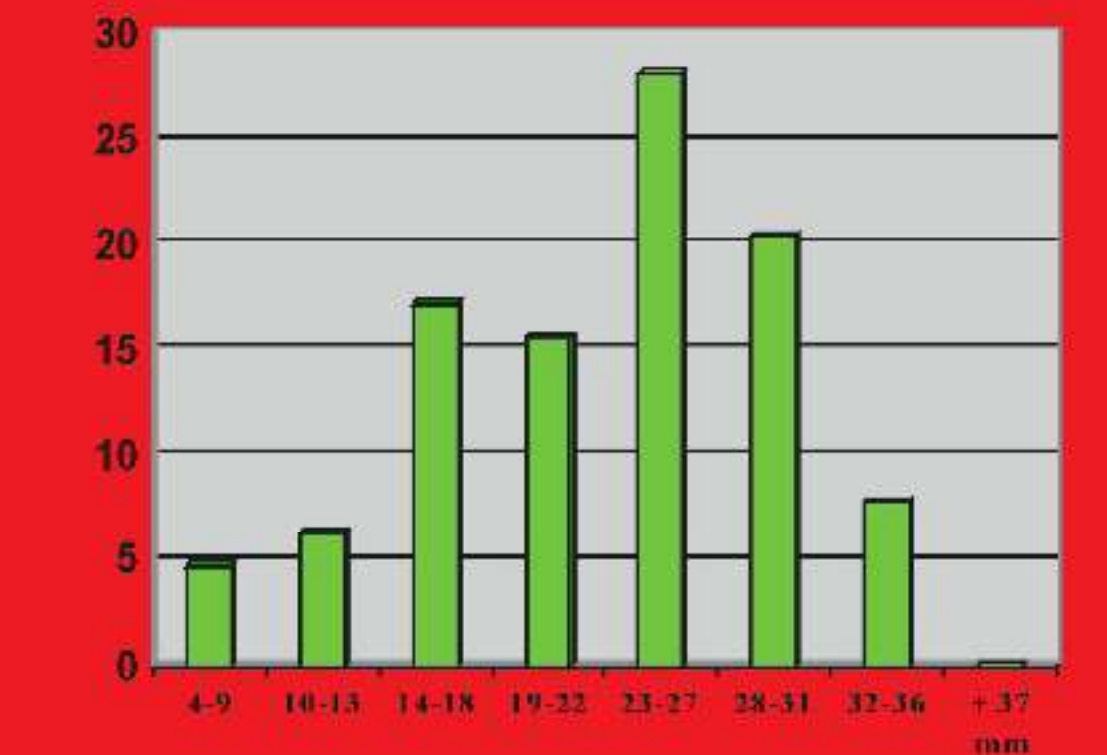


Elements of the blade production from Los Castillejos

 3-4 Cores recycled

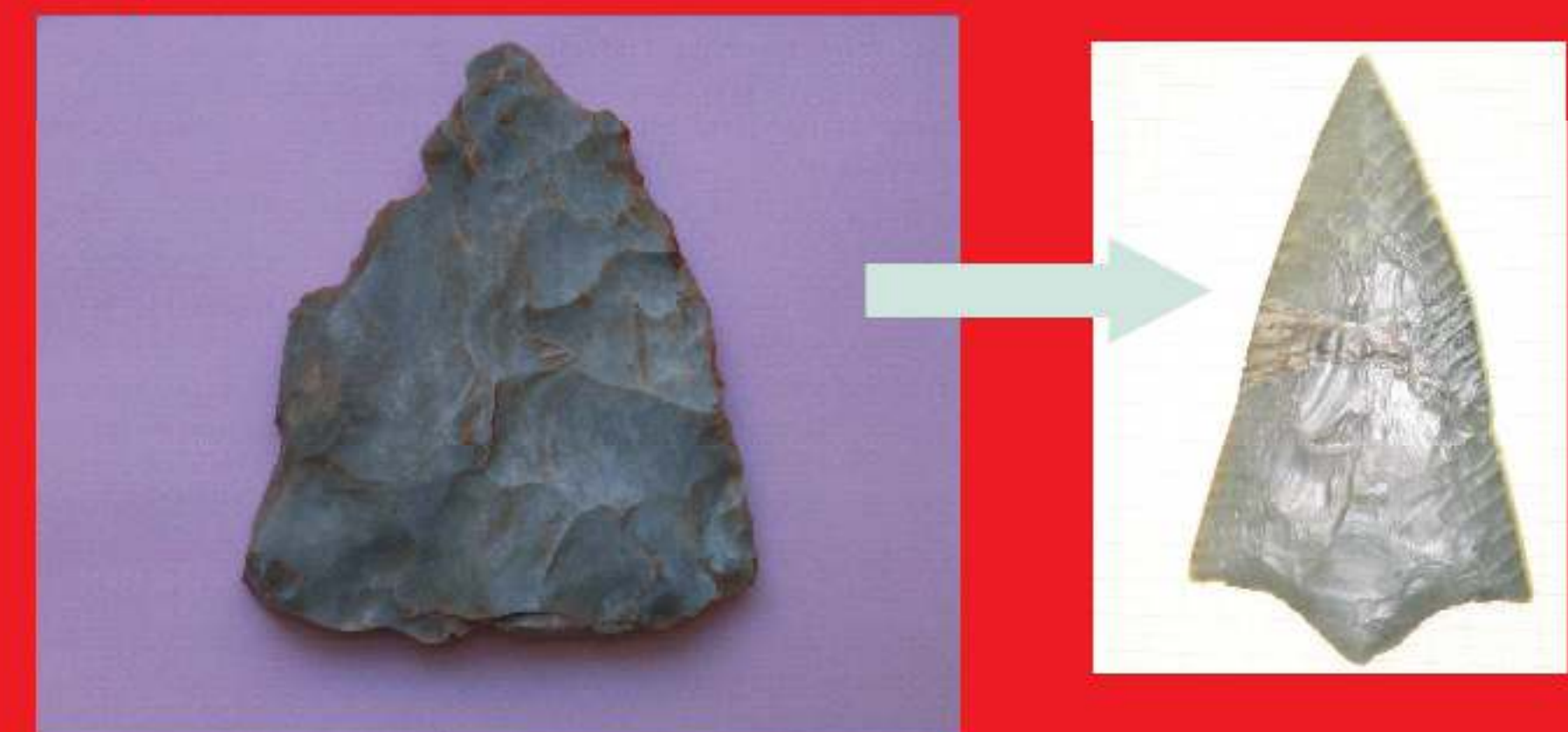
